## **ALL FUNCTIONS**

## **COLLECT**

EndNote Web allows you to "collect" bibliographic references and create a personal library by manually creating and importing full-text bibliographic records.





## **ORGANIZE**

References can be organized and sorted into individual folders.

# **FORMAT**

Bibliographic references can be formatted in the citation style chosen by the user and inserted into the text thanks to the interoperability of EndNote Web with the main writing programs thanks to the Cite While You Write plug-in.






### **SHARE**

Previously created folders can be shared with other EndNote Web subscribers in multiple ways.

### **MATCH**

The function which, thanks to the interaction between EndNote Web and Web of Science, makes it possible to find out which journals have thematic similarities with the collected references, guiding users in choosing the journal in which to publish.





### **CAPTURE REFERENCE**

Free to set up, Capture Reference is a browser bookmarklet that can be used to capture online references from web pages with a single click.

## **ENDNOTE CLICK**

Provides - simply and quickly - links to PDFs of articles from academic journals (provided they have a DOI or PMID identifier) accessible online on publishers' websites or in Open Access repositories.
